Learn what cookies are, why we use them, and how to update your cookie settings.

What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small file, usually consisting of letters and numbers, that is downloaded to a device when a user visits certain Web sites. Cookies allow a website to recognize the user's device. For more information, see "Cookies". <https://www.aboutcookies.org>.

We use Javascript, which is a widely used technology on the web, to detect and control these settings. If your browser does not support Javascript, you can [manage your cookie settings](#) through your web browser's security settings.

How we classify our cookies

Cookies and the technologies that use them vary significantly from website to website, so it is important that you understand how we classify the cookies we use on our website ("Website").

Other Cookies

Other Cookies are third-party cookies submitted by companies that we work with as part of our marketing initiatives. The third-party cookies that we use are listed below, and they provide third parties with information about your visit to our website.

Most of these "other cookies" are used to measure the effectiveness and performance of our pay-per-click advertising and display banners on third-party websites. While they collect your data, we try to ensure that the information they collect is anonymous.

Other cookies will:

- Measure the effectiveness of our promotional initiatives.
- Provide our partners with information about your visits to their websites.
- Collect information that can be used for advertising on other third-party websites.
- Send you targeted ads on third-party websites.

We do not guarantee that the cookies listed above are up to date, but we will make a reasonable effort to notify you of any changes.

Cookie settings

We use cookies to set and store your cookie preferences. However, if you delete this cookie when you clear the cookie cache, we will need to ask you to update your preferences again. We will also periodically ask you to confirm your cookie preferences. Cookies are set at the device level. This means that we will ask you to indicate your preferences if you visit our website from a different device. You can set your preferences for cookies below.
